# INDUSTRY PERSPECTIVE



## Contractor has sole design responsibility

- Promotes innovation, involvement and collaboration
- Changes in risk management
- Cost premium
- Changes in design input

## Principal's Requirements (PRs)

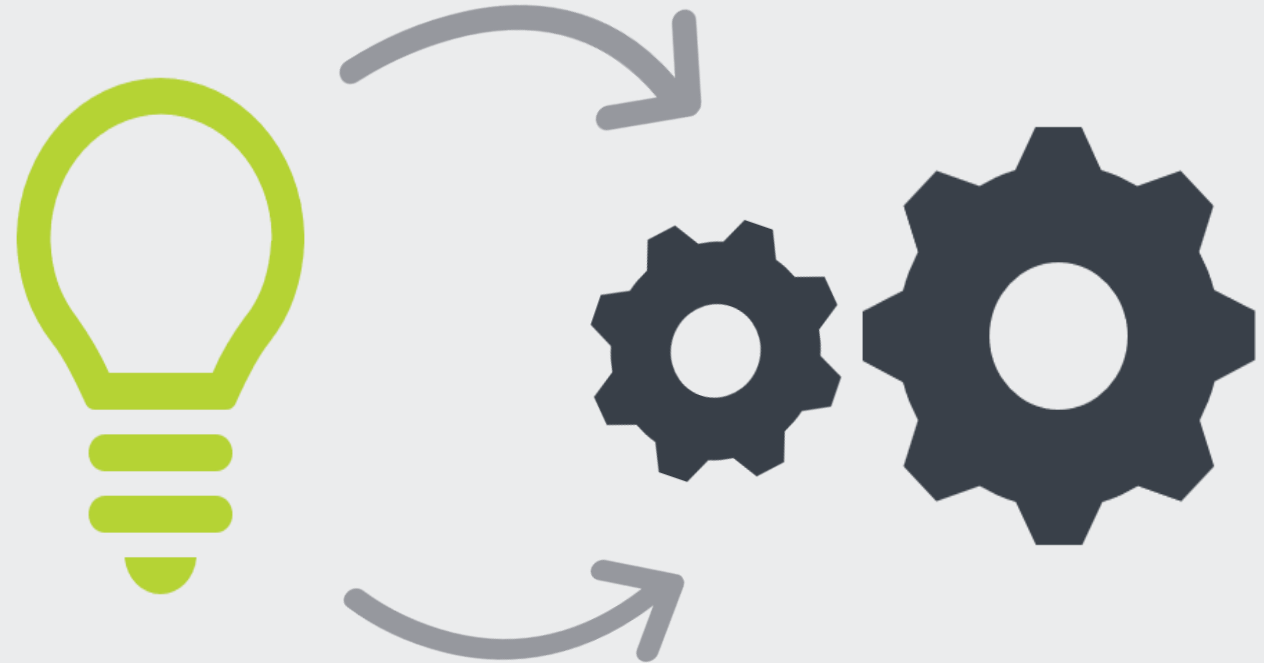
- Lack of quality of PRs
- Encourages optimisation
- Level of detail
- Reliance on experience and knowledge





## Structure and Execution

- Familiarity
- Faster delivery of projects
- Clearer design responsibilities
- Relationship of parties




# KEY IMPROVEMENTS



- Principal's Requirements
- Level of detail in tendering
- "Fit for purpose" is ambiguous
- Risk sharing mechanism
- Off-site materials
- Design-build-operate
- Safety in Design
