Inflow management and overflow control – future sewer separation programmes & use of control gates

Surge / pressure waves -  $\Sigma$  (inflows) >> outflow

Air, odour & H<sub>2</sub>S management

Grit / solids management


Impact on Mangere WWTP


Construction cost, staging, capitalisation

Evacuation management during construction


TBM fire & explosion risk


